Rom 13:8 *Owe no man any thing, but to love one another: for he that loveth another hath fulfilled the law.*

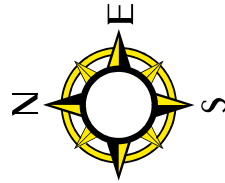
1 Cor 13:1 *Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, and have not charity, I am become as sounding brass, or a tinkling cymbal.*

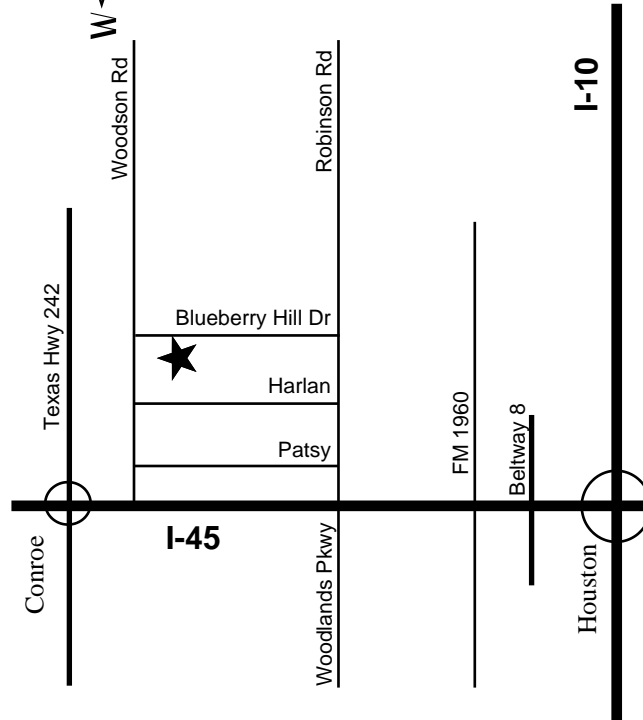

THE BIBLE

The Bible is the inspired, inerrant, and final authority in life and doctrine.

2 Pet 1:20-21 *Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation. For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost.*

2 Tim 3:16 *All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:*

GOD

One true God (Godhead) existing as the Father, Son and Holy Spirit (each possessing all the attributes of deity).

Matt 28:19 *Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:*

Deut 6:4 *Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD:*

Gen 1:26 *And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.*

GRACE

Salvation is a free gift from God. The only sufficient payment for our sins is the blood of Christ. It was through His death, as our substitute, that He paid the debt we owed. No one is saved by his own merits or good deeds.

GRACE (continued)

Eph 2:8-9 *For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.*

Rom 4:4 *Now to him that worketh is the reward not reckoned of grace, but of debt.*

Rom 5:15 *But not as the offence, so also is the free gift. For if through the offence of one many be dead, much more the grace of God, and the gift by grace, which is by one man, Jesus Christ, hath abounded unto many.*

OUR RESPONSE

It is necessary to respond to God's free offer of salvation by faith, repentance, and baptism. When we confess Christ as our Lord and are baptized (or immersed), God meets us, forgives our sins and gives us the gift of the Holy Spirit that empowers and guides us in our Christian walk through God's Word.

Acts 2:38 *Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.*

Rom 10:9-10 *That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.*

1 Pet 3:21 *The like figure whereunto even baptism doth also now save us (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ:*
